



ORDERED this 31th day of October, 2025, at 10:00 o'clock AM.




NOTICE

ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

Effective 10:00 AM, Friday, October 31, 2025, the Burn Ban will be lifted for San Augustine County will go into effect.

Therefore, the order, which is approved for outdoor burning as of 10:00 AM, October 31, 2025, is now in effect. This Order does not prohibit outdoor burning activities related to public health and safety that are authorized by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality for: (1) firefighter training; (2) public utility, natural gas pipeline or mining operations; (3) planting or harvesting of agricultural crops; or (4) burns that are conducted by a prescribed burn manager certified under Section 153.048, Natural Resources Code, and meet the standards of Section 153.047, Natural Resources Code.

In Accordance with Local Government Code 352.081(h), a violation of this Order is a Class C misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
