Proclamation

WHEREAS, Sexual Assault is a pervasive issue that affects individuals, families, and comities across our nation; and

WHEREAS, rape, sexual assault, and sexual harassment harm our communities, and every one of us has a role in protecting the people we love most; and

WHEREAS, every 68 seconds an American is sexually assaulted; and on average, only 33 out of 1000 cases of sexual assault end up with a conviction; and

WHEREAS, young people experience disproportionately higher rates of sexual violence between the ages of twelve and seventeen with college campus reports of one in five women and one in sixteen men who are sexually assaulted during their time in school; and


WHEREAS, we acknowledge the tireless work of advocates, allies, and community leaders who are committed to ending sex violence and providing support to survivors; and






