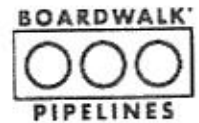


Texas Gateway Project



Boardwalk is a federally regulated interstate natural gas pipeline company that operates in full compliance with all federal and state regulations—ensuring safety, transparency, and accountability every step of the way.

Boardwalk employs approximately 1,290 people across its operations, supporting safe and reliable energy infrastructure.

In 2024, Boardwalk paid approximately \$45MM in taxes to Louisiana \$14MM to Texas.

The Texas Gateway Project will support multiple end use customers in the distribution of products, services and energy derived from natural gas.

DESCRIPTION

The Texas Gateway Project is an initiative by Boardwalk Pipelines to expand natural gas infrastructure across Texas and Louisiana. It will safely and efficiently deliver American-produced natural gas through new facilities and increased bidirectional capacity on our Index 129 mainline. This expansion helps meet growing demand from liquefied natural gas, industrial, and power users while enhancing energy security and driving economic growth.

The project entails installing one new compressor station, adding compression at two existing compressor stations, and constructing approximately 150-miles of 36-inch diameter pipeline. The proposed project would involve the following counties and parishes in Texas and Louisiana:

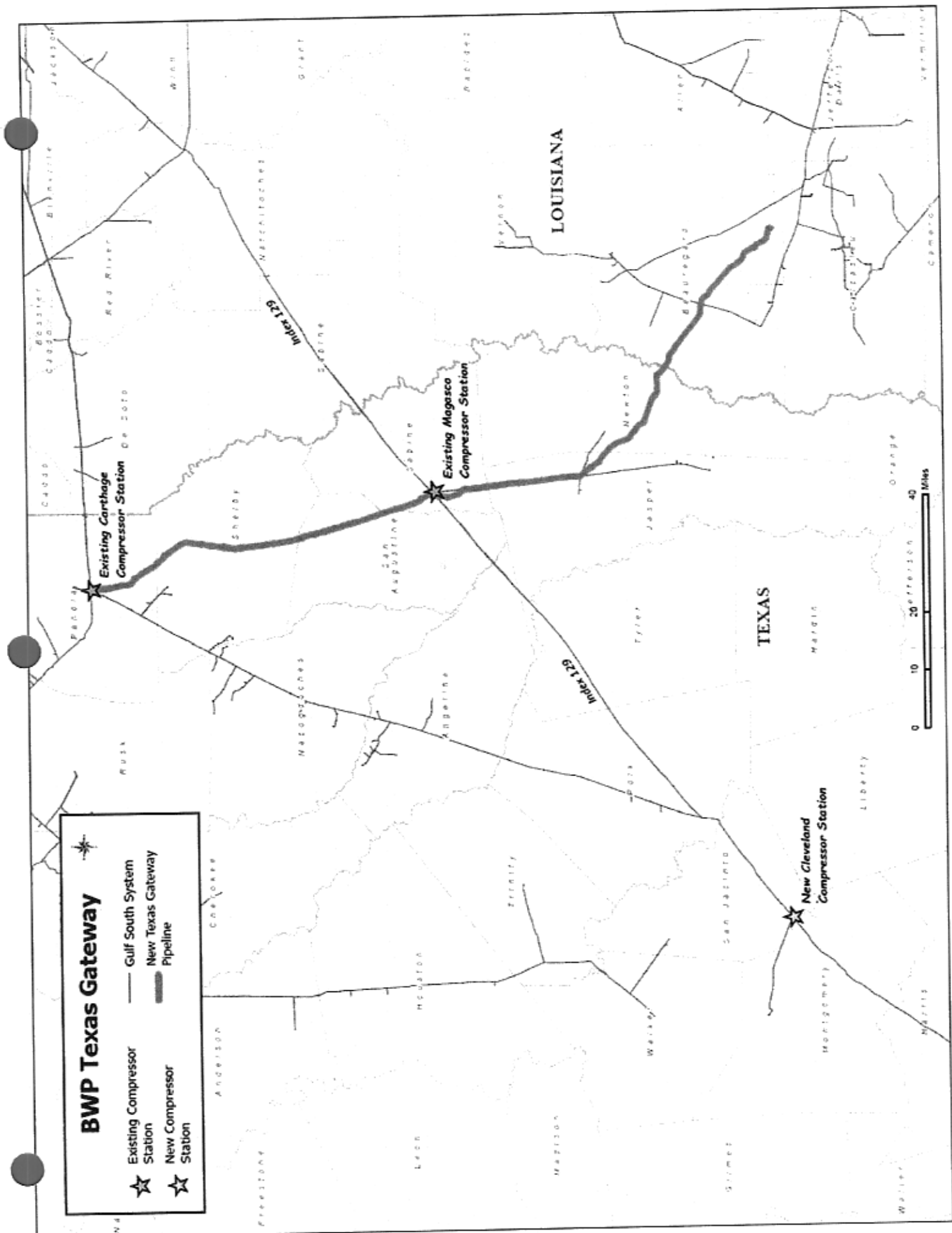
