#### 1. POLICY BACKGROUND AND OBJECTIVE

The adoption of this policy is to clarify and memorialize San Augustine County's traditional approach to allowing groups or individuals to assemble on San Augustine County owned property. This Policy clearly states the procedures and guidelines for individuals or groups seeking the use of County owned property. San Augustine County has stake in allowing the use of county owned property. Some of the considerations given in drafting this policy include:

- 1.1 The importance of county government property being accessible to the community;
- 1.2 The development of positive perceptions about local county government within San Augustine County, Texas;
- 1.3 Preserving the historical relationship that the local government of San Augustine County, Texas has had with the community;
- 1.4 Preserving the community values of San Augustine County, Texas;
- 1.5 Providing festive and seasonal decorations which are pleasant for not only members of our community, but invite and welcome visitors to San Augustine County, Texas;
- 1.6 Ensuring the safety of the community; and
- 1.7 Proving clarity to the public on San Augustine County's policies and procedures on the use of County property and the placement of displays on County property.

### 2. POLICY ON PUBLIC DISPLAYS, DECORATIONS, OR MONUMENTS ON COUNTY PROPERTY

- 2.1 Except those areas that have been established as public forums as a matter of law, San Augustine County property has not been by tradition or designation a public forum. San Augustine County may contract with individuals or private groups to place displays or decorate County property, however, any displays placed on County property are for San Augustine County's intended purpose;
- 2.2 Any personal property left unattended on County property will be removed;
- 2.3 No permanent structures, fixtures or displays will be permitted on County property without prior County Commissioners Court approval;

- 2.4 Any requests for displays, decorations, or monuments shall be made in writing and directed to the San Augustine County Judge. The written request should include:
  - 2.4.1 The name of the individual and organization making the request;
  - 2.4.2 A description of the item(s) requested to be displayed on County Property;
  - 2.4.3 The location upon County Property where you would like to place the display;
  - 2.4.4 The date you would like to begin the display, and the name, address and telephone number of the person who will be responsible for erecting the display;
  - 2.4.5 The date the display will end and the name address and telephone number of the person who will be responsible for removing the display.
- 2.5 With respect to requests made pursuant to Section 2.0 of this policy, the County Judge may approve the request, are at their discretion, and may place the request on a Commissioner Court Agenda for consideration by the Commissioners Court. If any single County Commissioner disapproves of the County Judge's approval or denial of a request, the Commissioner can have the matter placed on a Commissioner Court Agenda for consideration by the Commissioners Court as a whole.
- 2.6 It is acknowledged that the County Commissioners Court has control over any monument, display, or decoration placed on County property. The County Commissioners Court specifically reserves the right to:
  - Approve or deny, in whole or in part, any request for display on County property;
  - 2.6.2 Rescind or modify any approval of a display;
  - 2.6.3 Control the location of the display and set the duration to allow the display, if any;
  - 2.6.4 Control the message that is delivered to the public by the use of property owned by San Augustine County.

#### APPENDIX A

### AGREEMENT ON TERMS AND CONDITIONS OR USE OF

#### SAN AUGUSTINE COUNTY TEXAS PROPERTY

A.3.0	Rules of Use
A.3.1	Users are responsible for clean-up of the County property during and at the conclusion the event;
A.3.2	There will be <b>NO USE</b> of County electricity, water, or other utilities unless prior approval granted. The permissible use of outdoor property does not contemplate the use of any indoor facilities and the use of indoor facilities or utilities will not be authorized without express approval by County Judge;
A.3.3	There will be <b>NO</b> overnight demonstrations or camping on County property. Use of County property for multiple days does not authorize overnight stays;
A.3.4	DRUGS AND ALCOHOL ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON ALL COUNTY PROPERTY;
A.3.5	County property shall be vacated promptly at the expiration of event permit;
A.3.6	No breach of peace or disruptive assembly or demonstration is allowed. Excessive noise or disturbance of the peace will result in the Premises Permit will be revoked immediately and the event canceled;
A.3.7	Firearms are strictly prohibited; only exceptions are Certified Peace Officers;
A.3.8	No portable toilets may be placed on County property without prior approval from the County Judge;

#### A.4.0 Agreement on Condition of Use

The User agrees to the following as a condition of use:

- A.4.1 Adherence to all of the rules listed above in A.3.0 and the applicant's best efforts to ensure that all event attendees are in adherence;
- A.4.2 User assumes the duty to inspect the premises prior to use for any unsafe condition and to notify a representative of San Augustine County if an unsafe condition is found. In the event that any unsafe condition that is found, that cannot be corrected or cured prior to the start of the event, the event should be canceled;
- A.4.3 Once a County premises become unsafe, please notify a San Augustine County representative.
- A.4.4 Not to interfere in any way with the operation of county business;
- A.4.5 Make ensure that attendees and the property of San Augustine County, Texas, from harm or damage;
- A.4.6 Not to build, erect, affix, and attach, any equipment or permanent structure to any structure or fixture upon San Augustine. When attaching temporary displays for use during permitted event times, users will not use nails, screws, or any similar fasteners to attach said displays to County structures or fixtures, including the trees and landscaping on County property;

THE USE OF ELECTRICAL OUTLETS ON THE COURTHOUSE BUILDING IS STRICKLY PROHIBITED. VIOLATION OF THIS POLICY WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE COURTHOUSE GROUNDS

- A.4.7 To ensure that no illegal activity is taking place on County property; and
- A.4.8 To report any damage to County property as soon as it is known.

#### A.5.0 Defense, Indemnity, and Release of San Augustine County

- A.5.1 Applicant agrees that San Augustine County will not be responsible for any losses, whatsoever.
- A.5.2 APPLICANT HEREBY AGREES TO RELEASE FROM LIABILITY, DEFEND, AND INDEMNIFY SAN AUGUSTINE COUNTY TEXAS, ITS OFFICERS, ELECTED OFFICIALS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES FROM ANY AND ALL LIABILITY, SPECIFICALLY INDCLUDING, BUT IN NO WAY LIMITED TO ANY ACCIDENTS OR EVENTS CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF SAN AUGUSTINE COUNTY, TEXAS, INCLUDING GROSS NEGLIGENCE, OR ITS OFFICERS, ELECTED OFFICIALS, AGENTS, AND EMPLOYEES, WHETHER IS BE PROPERTY DAMAGE OR PERONAL INJURY (INDLUDING DEATH), ARISING OUT OF THE APPLICANT'S USE OF COUNTY PROPERTY.

#### A.6.0 Default

- A.6.1 Applicant agrees that any violation of any of the Rules, Terms, or Conditions of this agreement can result in revocation of any permit, and the immediate cancelation of any scheduled event, assembly, or demonstration.
- A.6.2 In addition to the above, Applicant also agrees that any violation may result in the denial of any future application of Applicant or Applicant's Organization.
- A.6.3 Applicant agrees to repair or to make full restitution to San Augustine County for any damage to County property as a result of Applicant's event.
